

## Review of: "A Novel Anti-Gravitational Thread Pathway Technique to Promote Face Lift: Technical Report"

The author proposes the technique as novel and I agree with this. The article is didactic and easy to understand for the reader.

The author refers that the technique is not very invasive but even so, in my opinion, in order to be clear about the planes of action, route and entry with the cannula, it would be necessary a deeper learning both at a theoretic level and in the daily practice in the clinics.

In this way we would avoid the appearance of undesired side effects.

It should be added that, although the article is clear and well written, it omits everything related to the most common possible adverse effects and their durability, as well as any possibility of reversing them in order to avoid discomfort for the patient.

It is also unclear whether the study is longitudinal and how long the technique has been in practice in order to be able to anticipate not only adverse effects but also to assess the durability of the results.

Finally, it is not clear from the article what type of PDO threads are recommended (spiculated, etc.). It would be interesting to be more precise when mentioning the product.
